George Cook / Jefferson, New Hampshire, USA

Ann Mariah Cook and her husband George Cook have been involved with Siberian Huskies since 1978 and have been members of the Siberian Husky Club of America (SHCA) for over 25 years. They have shown dogs in conformation, competed in obedience trials, and have raced teams of Siberian Huskies in major competitions including the Yukon Quest. Their Alkas'iber Kennels teams have twice won the SHCA Lombard-Norris Distance Award for the best long-distance team. They have also won the coveted SHCA Working/Showing trophy for the team that is most outstanding in both

race and show. Numerous team dogs have won distinctions in regional specialty shows, including Best in Specialty Show (BISS), Best Sled Dog, High in Trial (HIT), and Awards of Merit at both the regional and national level.

Ann Mariah is an AKC approved judge for Siberian Huskies and Alaskan Malamutes. A professional writer, she has contributed her skills to various breed and all-breed publications including Purebred Dogs/ The American Kennel Gazette, The Complete Siberian Husky (Demidoff/Jennings), and the International Siberian Husky Club (ISHC) Presents the Siberian Husky. Her popular non-fiction novel "Running North" has been published in 5 languages. Ann Mariah has twice been the recipient of Dog Writers' Association of America awards. She has been active on organizational committees for AKC Specialty Shows, was a founding member of SHCA Rescue, and is an SHCAapproved Mentor, having served the Judges' Education Committee for over 15 years. She has been invited by breed clubs in the United States, Canada, South America, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, and The Peoples Republic of China to judge and lecture on the Breed Standards, especially as they apply to working dogs. She has appeared on radio and television shows as a spokesman for Siberian Huskies and the sport of mushing. George has judged numerous Sweepstakes assignments, in the United States and Europe. He was on the Board of Directors of the SHCA for 8 years, and is the former Chair of the SHCA Working Committee. He was an appointed committee member of 3 successive Standard Review Committees. An SHCA-approved Mentor, he has served the Judges' Education Committee for the past 10 years. George is a Regional Director of the International Sled Dog Racing Association (ISDRA) and has also been the Secretary of ISDRA for the past 12 years. He is currently serving as a member of the New Hampshire Governor's Commission for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, and is a legislative "watchdog", working on behalf of animal owners. George also trains and competes with his horses in the sport of Eventing.

Ann Mariah and George live with their 16 Siberian Huskies, five horses, and one cat in northern New Hampshire, in the Town of Jefferson.

There will be a banquet dinner (see below for dinner reservations) following the National Specialty on Sunday evening including a debriefing of the dogs exhibited at the specialty as well as a presentation by George Cook:

"Form Follows Function, and how it is demonstrated by long distance racing", which will include slides of the Yukon Quest, Labrador 400, and will show both the beauty and terror of our sport.
